Fire service providers/vendors can view claim information online instead of calling into Claims via the Fire Claim View Tool on the State Farm[®] Business to Business (B2B) Portal.


Service providers will need to log in on the B2B Portal to access the tool.


- 1. Access the State Farm® Business to Business (B2B) Portal (b2b.statefarm.com) and click "Need to register?"

- 2. Click **Fire service** on the *Claim services* page.




3. Click Fire claim view tool on the Fire Service page.



Search Claim

Once the Fire Claim View tool is launched, the user will be required to enter the claim number, date of loss, and insured name.



Claim Found

If a claim is found based on the information entered by the user, the following information will display to the user:

- Claim Status
- Loss Location
- Payment Details

Note: Only payments made to the logged-on vendor will display. Payments to insureds, claimants or other Service Providers will not show.

Contactor Comments

Note: information entered here after clicking Submit, will be sent to the claim handler for follow up.

- Claim Handler information
- Document Upload

Note: Upload button will take user to separate upload tool.
